# SLOTS LINK - State Licensing and Online Tracking System

- Online application process utilizing the internet.
- Initial focus is on the gaming employees, with expansion to the non-gaming employees and vendors.
- Licensing, BIE, and the Office of the Chief Counsel are an integral part of this development.
- Fully automated to assemble all the required information for the licensing review and reporting.



# SLOTS LINK - State Licensing and Online Tracking System

- Targeted live date for the online application process is mid July.
- Back end reporting and workflow by September.
- A Development Resource Group representing all key bureaus will provide input and assistance to the project.
- Staffing with 5 developers through the state IT staff augmentation contract.



# SLOTS LINK - State Licensing and Online Tracking System Applicant Account Initialization

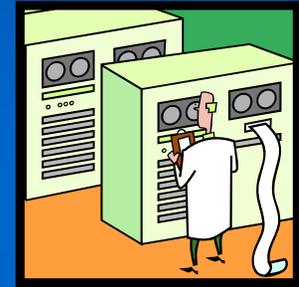

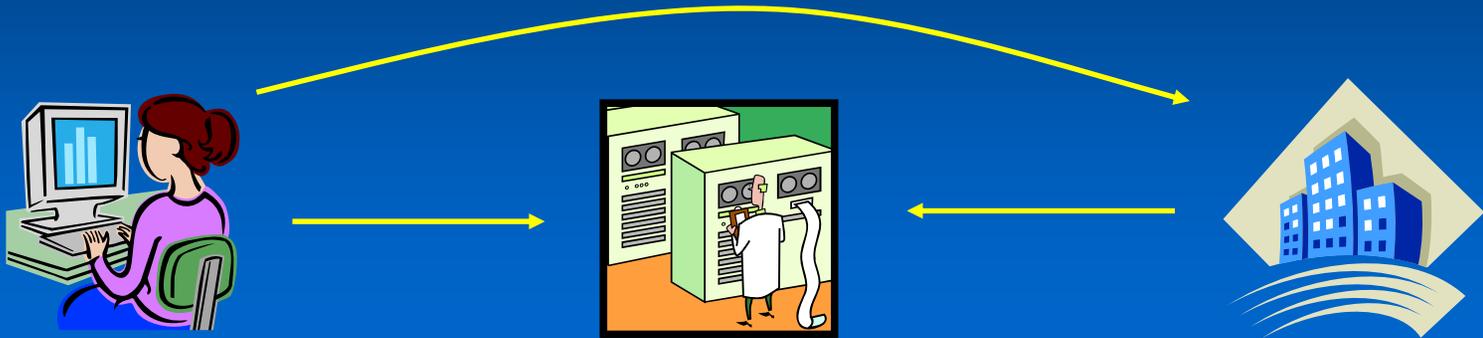
Employer offers an individual a job that needs to be licensed by the PGCB.

Employer logs onto SLOTS LINK to enter basic demographic and employment information to set up this individual's (applicant) user account.

Logon information and instructions are printed for the applicant with their User ID and a password to complete application at home or at the potential employer's place of business.



# SLOTS LINK - State Licensing and Online Tracking System Applicant Input



Applicant answers a brief online questionnaire to determine which sections of the application must be completed. Customized instructions are printed.

Applicant completes the online application at home or at their employer's facility.

Error checking for missing or incorrect information will be completed prior to submission.

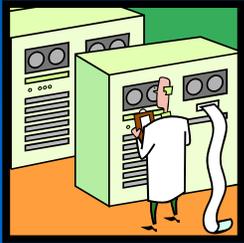
Applicant returns to their employer to sign all the required paperwork.

Employer retains copies of all the signed documents for later inspections by the PGCB.

Employer logs onto SLOTS LINK to approve the processing of the applicant's background check by the PGCB.



# SLOTS LINK - State Licensing and Online Tracking System PGCB Automation



Selected data from each applicant's application will be electronically sent to the appropriate organizations for their processing.



Segmented data is sent to BIE for approval prior to sending to the state police.



Segmented tax authorization data is sent to DOR.



Segmented data is sent to the DPW.



Receipt is sent to the applicant and the employer.



Authorizes payment from employer to PGCB.

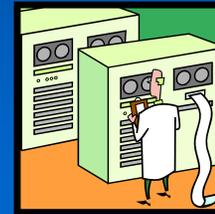


PSP status is sent

PGCB reviews  
the data and  
pursues any  
deficiencies.



BIE investigates  
any deficiencies.



Licensing requests  
additional information  
and clarifications.



Licensing prepares report to the Gaming  
Control Board for ruling on the applicant.



# SLOTS LINK - State Licensing and Online Tracking System

## Ruling and Final Reporting



The Gaming Control Board provides a Ruling on Gaming Applicant.



Employers and applicants will be informed on the actions of the Board.



If approved, credentials will be produced and mailed to the employers to be given to the applicants.
